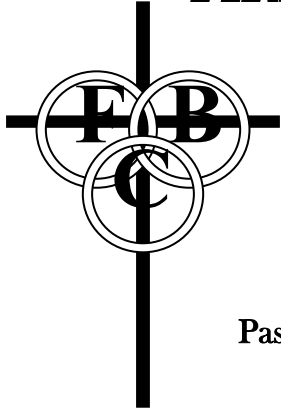

FBC CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

First Baptist wants you to know that the health and safety of our members, guests, employees, and neighbors is always our top priority. We've developed a crisis response plan to ensure we are doing what is best for you during this public health threat posed by the Coronavirus.

- Ministry In-Person Meetings are cancelled for March. All FBC ministries are requested to hold March meetings via telephone conference or web conference or to cancel for the month of March.
- Barnabas will provide to-go meals only on March 26th.
- March 21st Church Meeting is rescheduled for Saturday, April 18th.
- Sunday School and Bible Study are cancelled for remainder of March.
- Sunday, March 22nd Baptisms will be rescheduled for April.
- Palm Sunday Music & Arts Celebration is cancelled for 2020.
- The campus is closed to all non-FBC organizations and functions for the remainder of March.

We ask that you continue, each week, to give your financial gifts to our kingdom work. CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) PRECAUTIONS

The 2019 Novel Coronavirus, or COVID-19, is a new respiratory virus. Coronaviruses affect the respiratory system, including the lungs and airways. It is contagious among humans and there is no vaccine available. Coronaviruses are primarily spread through close contact, through respiratory droplets from coughs and sneezes within a range of about 6 feet. To protect yourself, family, church and co-workers do the following:

- **Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.**
- Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer (60% or higher) only if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth as much as possible.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or sleeve (not hands) when coughing or sneezing.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- ***Stay home if you are sick, think you may be sick, develop symptoms, have a compromised respiratory system, have compromised health during this time.**
- **Avoid contact with sick people as much as possible.**
- Avoid non-essential travel.

Sunday School Lesson This Week

March 22: Micah 3:1-2, 9-12; 6:6-8. “Corrupt Leaders.” or “Doing Justice.” People looked to their leaders then, (as we do now) to be positive role models, above reproach, not susceptible to scandal or corruption. In today’s lesson the prophet, Micah, confronts Israel’s leaders for their failures: *“The Lord has told you what is good and what He requires of you: to do what is right, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God.”* (v. 8 NLT)
